Updated Addresses: A Valuable Service

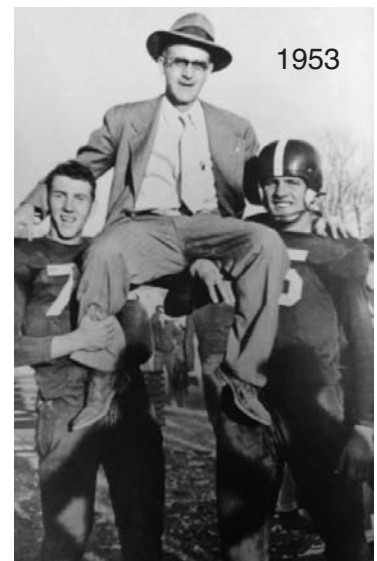

There are Four Different Ways to Contribute to the Norse Fund:



1. Unrestricted Contributions

Most of our funds are received by donations made by friends of the Norse Fund with no restrictions made on how their contribution is to be used. This type of donation allows the Board to use the monies received in any way that benefits the Norse Fund.



2. Flow-Through Contributions

Flow-through contributions are funds of \$500 or more that the donor wants to be awarded to one or more students. These types of contributions have to be communicated to the Board by March 1st, and funds have to be received by May 1st to be awarded at the Spring Award Presentation. Minimum amounts are generally \$500, but other amounts may be considered.



3. Time-Restricted Contributions

These types of contributions are a form of restricted funds that the donor wants the Norse Fund to hold and award over time. Time-restricted contributions have to be at a minimum of \$1,000 but can be for larger amounts. The Board holds these funds and awards a minimum of \$500 each year to one or more students.



4. Permanently Restricted Contributions

Permanently restricted contributions are also called endowed contributions. This is where a donor contributes a larger sum of monies that is invested to yield an amount that is annually awarded to one or more students. From time to time, the policies on permanently restricted minimum contributions and yields have changed. The current Permanently Restricted Contribution levels are:

- \$ 5,000.00 Contribution = \$250.00 Scholarship
- \$ 7,500.00 Contribution = \$375.00 Scholarship
- \$10,000.00 Contribution = \$500.00 Scholarship

Upon acceptance of the money the board will not change the scholarship amounts.

Norse Fund Reaches Milestone

With the granting of scholarships to the WHS Class of 2012, the Norse Fund has reached a very significant milestone. This year, the total dollar amount of scholarships awarded over the 25 year history of the Fund has surpassed the \$1,000,000 mark. What began in 1987 with a handful of \$100 awards has grown to an annual scholarship distribution of over \$60,000, touching the lives of 30 to 40 graduates each year.

The success of the Norse Fund is due primarily to the generosity of the people and businesses who have supported the organization with their monetary donations. Each and every donation, large or small, is an investment in the future of our young adults as they seek to further their education.

Thank you to everyone who has made a donation over the past 25 years. Without your support, reaching the \$1,000,000 landmark would not have been possible.

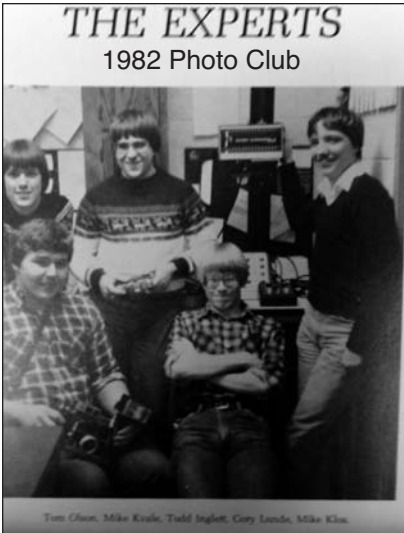

Comments from Past Norse Fund Award Recipient

I am writing this letter to show my appreciation for the financial support that you provide Westby Area High School graduates and to ask that you to continue said support for future graduates. This appreciation is neither general nor arbitrarily given. As a past recipient of a Norse Fund Board scholarship, my gratitude is both personal and deeply felt. Since the rising costs of higher education has been the subject of much attention lately, it is easy to assume that a local scholarship may be pointless or just a "drop in the bucket." However, my purpose in writing this letter is to tell you that my experience has proven this to be false.

With the help of my local scholarships, the University of Minnesota's government-sponsored financial aid covered the difference between the income I was able to generate and the cost of attending college. Though I was not able to graduate debt-free, I was able to avoid private student loans with higher interest rates and reduce the amount that I borrowed. That being said, the monetary value of the scholarships I received literally grows every day, and the peace of mind that this lowered financial burden affords me is immeasurable.

Of course, college is still expensive, but the fact still remains that the Norse Fund scholarships help our graduates start their academic careers at institutions of higher education. This financial support allows individuals from the Westby area to represent our community at colleges all over the country. It would seem that the need for these scholarships will only increase with the cost of tuition, making them even more important for future graduates.

Again, thank you for everything you have done for me and continue to do for Westby area students.
